

Hygiene concept Kommunale Galerien Tempelhof-Schöneberg

Haus am Kleistpark, Haus am Kleistpark I Projektraum,
Galerie im Tempelhof Museum, April 17th, 2021



Based on the general hygiene concept of the Senate Department for Culture and Europe from April 13th, 2021.

From March 16th, 2021, the locations of the municipal galleries can be visited again with a confirmed appointment booking. With our hygiene concept, we want to ensure that the visit runs smoothly and protect visitors and employees from infection as well as possible. All measures listed correspond to the requirements of the above-mentioned framework hygiene concept and the Second Sars-CoV-2 Infection Protection Measures Ordinance:

Appointment booking

A visit can only be made if an appointment has been made in advance by telephone. Time slot bookings of one hour are Monday to Friday 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., on weekends 11 am to 4 pm on (030) 90277-4979 possible. The appointment confirmation will be sent by email and should be brought to the visit.

Time slot

The maximum length of stay per exhibition house is one hour. The scheduled appointments always start on the hour.

Contact tracking

For contact tracking purposes, the following data will be collected at the time of registration: First and last name, full address or email and phone number. These are confirmed on the spot and kept securely for four weeks without access by third parties. At the end of this period, the data will be destroyed.

Antigen test

The exhibition can only be visited with a certified negative antigen test from the the same day.

Own antigen self-tests can be brought along and performed on site under supervision. Testing is not mandatory for children under 6 years of age.

If proof of a complete vaccination with a vaccine against SARS-CoV-2 approved in the EU at least 14 days ago is provided, the testing obligation does not apply.

FFP2-Mask

Wearing a FFP2-mask is mandatory during the entire visit. Children from age 6 to 14 can wear medical masks instead.

Spacing rules

Care must be taken at all times to maintain a distance of at least 1.5 meters from other persons.

Visitor services should point this out upon entry.

Since it is not possible to set up separate entrances and exits at many locations, special attention must be paid to maintaining the distance in this area.

Hand disinfection

Visitors must disinfect their hands upon entering the exhibition buildings. Disinfectant is available at the entrance to each location.

Ventilation

At all locations, the Visitor Service ensures that there is sufficient ventilation. Rooms that have no ventilation at all will be closed to visitor traffic.

Maximum number of persons allowed

The maximum number of people allowed depends on the total size of the exhibition space. Per visitor 40 square meters are available.

In practice, this means for the locations:

Haus am Kleistpark I Large exhibition hall: 5 persons at a time, plus supervision.

Haus am Kleistpark I Project Room: 1 person per room, plus supervision

Galerie im Tempelhof Museum: 1 person, plus supervision

Protection of employees

At each location, the visitor service workplace is equipped with a spit shield. All employees are provided with FFP2 masks and antigen tests.

Additional rules at individual locations

Wearing gloves is mandatory in order to view books/catalogs or touch interactive exhibits. Disposable gloves will be provided.
