

# Hygiene concept Municipal Galleries Tempelhof-Schöneberg

The locations of the municipal galleries can be visited in compliance with the hygiene rules. With our hygiene concept, we want to ensure a smooth visit and protect visitors and staff from infection in the best possible way. All the measures listed comply with the requirements of the above-mentioned hygiene framework concept and the Second Sars-CoV-2 Infection Protection Measures Ordinance:

### **Compulsory testing**

The presentation of a certified negative antigen test is not required for the exhibition visit.

### **Facemask**

Wearing an medical or FFP2 mask is compulsory during the entire visit to the house.

### **Distance rules**

Care should always be taken to keep a distance of at least 1.5 metres from other people. The visitor service should point this out upon entry.

As it is not possible to set up a separate entrance and exit at many locations, particular attention must be paid to maintaining the distance in this area.

### **Hand disinfection**

Visitors must disinfect their hands when entering the exhibition halls.

Disinfectant is available at the entrance to each site.

### **Ventilation**

At all locations, the visitor service ensures that there is sufficient ventilation. Rooms that have no ventilation at all will be closed to visitors.

### **Maximum number of persons allowed**

The maximum number of people allowed depends on the total size of the exhibition space. 10 square metres are available per visitor.

In practice, this means for the locations:

**Haus am Kleistpark I Large exhibition hall:** 18 people at the same time, plus supervision

**Haus am Kleistpark I Project room:** 3 people per room, plus supervision

**Gallery in the Tempelhof Museum:** 5 persons, plus supervision

### **Protection of employees**

At each location, the visitor service workplace is equipped with a spit shield. All staff members are provided with FFP2 masks and antigen tests during work.

### **Additional rules at individual locations**

To be able to look at books/catalogues or touch interactive exhibition objects, the wearing of gloves is obligatory. Disposable gloves will be provided.
