

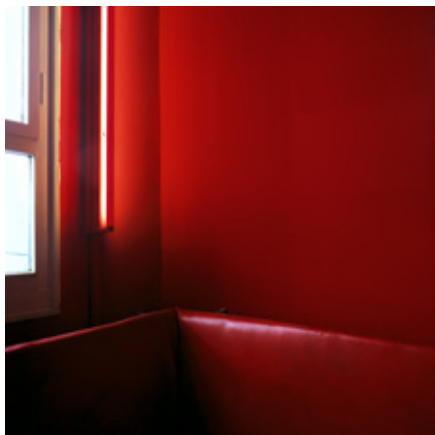

# Anna Lehmann-Brauns

## Junimond

From 27 August until 31 October 2021 the Haus am Kleistpark is proud to present Anna Lehmann-Brauns' (\*1967) exhibition "Junimond". The artist, who divides her time between Berlin and Leipzig, produces photographic images that invite us into unique spaces. The current exhibition covers a time span of over 20 years.

Anna Lehmann-Brauns began her artistic career with the series "Bitterblue", a series of enlarged photographs of the miniature houses she had built, illuminated, and photographed. Here already we see Anna Lehmann-Braun's fascination for light, surface, and colours as well as her fine sense for magic.

Her pictures involve us in a game with reality, invite us into a theatre of memories that, precisely through the absence of any protagonists, refers to life while opening up space for speculation. Later, Lehmann-Brauns began to photograph found spaces, but these are stage-like too. They become a form of aesthetic and social study but one which does not document; on the contrary, it is a form which seems to focus more on dreams lived than on what is.

By choosing to name her exhibition after Rio Reiser's 1986 song of the same name, Anna Lehmann-Brauns both recalls a West Berlin of the eighties as a formative era for her visual worlds and locates us mentally within a very specific time: for Lehmann-Brauns, the daughter of parents involved in the student movement, that of a youth and early adulthood spent between the Runway 18 West protests, the women's movement, group houses, and punk. With its intense light and special colours, her most recent work, created in Turkey, is similarly captivating. Whether capturing Istanbul's grand hotels which once heralded the dawn of modernity, ferries, or simply the edge of a street – Anna Lehmann Brauns transforms everything she sees into unforgettable scenes.

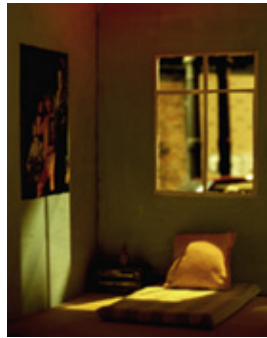

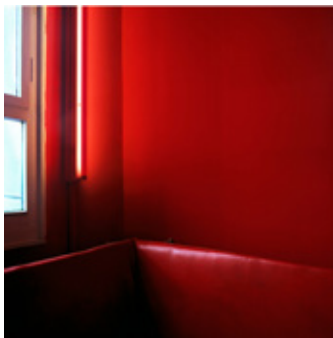

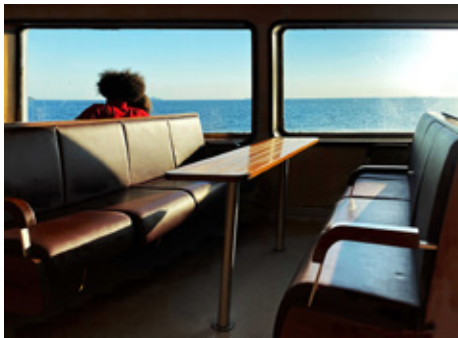
